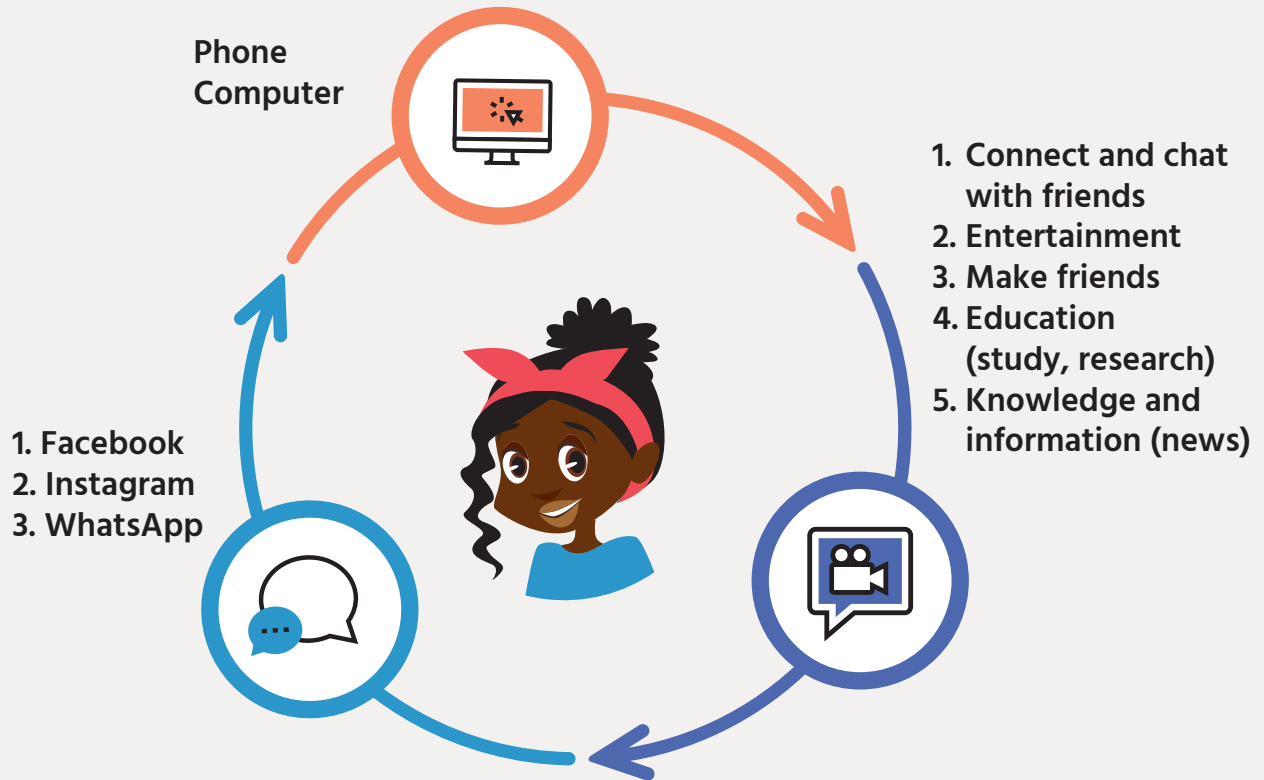

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- Discuss with parents their role in monitoring children & young people's internet use
- Promote general awareness on internet use and safety with children & young people
- Doing awareness drive in the community
- Creating and delivering parents' education on internet use
- Having a 'internet safety champion' to promote awareness

WHAT CAN CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE DO?

- Only accept friends request from people they know and trust in real life
- Do not meet physically with anyone they only know online as sometimes people pretend to be someone else online
- If someone is upsetting them online, block the person and tell an adult they trust to ask for help
- Do not tag or share their locations online as such information is personal and should be kept private for their safety
- If they want to share photos or videos online, permission must be asked from the people involved
- Never share photos or videos that might upset or embarrass anyone as it is considered cyberbullying
